### Make Your Voice Heard As End of 2008 Session Nears

#### *Floor votes possible as soon as this week*

**Action:** A number of our targeted bills could be heard on the floor of the Assembly or Senate **at any time**. Several are shown below. Please call, fax or e-mail your assemblymember or state senator asking him or her to oppose these bills as noted. Our [Targeted Bills list](#) is updated as needed when votes and other actions occur. **E-Verify Prohibition – AB 2076** prohibits the state from participating in employment verification systems, like the E-Verify through the Department of Homeland Security, to establish residency prior to employment. In addition, the bill reaches into local affairs barring cities and counties from requiring that employers in their jurisdictions utilize such systems. **Ask your state senator to oppose AB 2076.**

**Financial Aid for Illegal Aliens – AB 2083** requires California State University and community colleges (as well as University of California, if approved by the Regents) to offer tuition assistance (grants, scholarships and student loans) to some students who are in this country illegally. **Ask your state senator to oppose AB 2083.**

**Harvey Milk Day – AB 2567** designates May 22 as “Harvey Milk Day” in California public schools. Bill text identifies Milk as “the first openly gay man to be elected to public office in a major city.” AB 2567 is another attempt to normalize the homosexual lifestyle through schools. **Ask your state senator to oppose AB 2567.**

**End of Life Care – AB 2747** requires that health care providers who diagnose a terminal illness provide the patient with all legal end-of-life options or a referral to a provider who will do so, including voluntary stopping of eating and drinking. The primary proponent is the same organization sponsoring last year’s physician-assisted suicide bill. **Ask your state senator to oppose AB 2747.**

**Driver’s Licenses for Illegal Aliens – SB 60** requires the Department of Motor Vehicles to issue licenses under the federal REAL ID Act to persons who are not legal residents of the United States. Licenses will not be acceptable for federal identification or other official purposes. **Ask your assemblymember to oppose SB 60.** (This two-year bill is in its second house.)
